## Boston Common meets Uncommon Style at "Park Residence" featuring Weiss Panels

Working closely with the contractor, Weiss developed a panel system which could be installed one side at a time so that staging was minimized.

Park Residence is an 18 story project for which Weiss Sheet Metal fabricated a wide variety of architectural metal parts. Custom canopies and column covers accentuated entry ways and roof coping by Weiss topped off the structure.

The attractive panel system for the structure was fabricated at the Weiss Sheet Metal shop in Avon, MA. The





panels were manufactured with a male and a female interlocking sides, requiring custom extrusions, into which the panel's edge could fit. The final assembly of the front and back side of each panel required welding and the addition of a stiffener.

This large scale project required custom Kynar paint with the look of clear anodized. Three layers of "silver gown" colored Kynar were applied to achieve the final result.

Most interesting was the final construction of the project. The contractor wanted to work on one side of the structure at a time to minimize staging, so panels had to be completed on one side before starting on the next.
